Class write-up / description	Let's make this adorable handbag together! You've seen the sample at the shop but you are just a little intimidated. All you need is a little handholding. Come with an open mind, and we will show you the steps.

Pre-requisites for class	Must be willing to learn new techniques, be confident with cast on, knitting, purling, bidding off
Materials needed for class	<p>Choice A – (like sample) 4 colors + 1 contrast MC1-65yds CC-76yds MC2-44yds MC3-52yds MC4-82yds Plied – Penn Ave.</p> <p>Choice B – 1 gradient + 1 contrast MC-243yds of a gradient or self stripping yarn CC-76yds of a contrast</p> <p>Size US#3 needle (straight or circ 24") Small round plain stitch markers of different colors Size E or F crochet hook Small amount of smooth waste yarn – DK or light worsted</p>

Skills/techniques learned	Provisional CO, Short Rows, Grafting, Icord, Picking up stitches, knitting flat and in the round, lateral braid.
Homework required (please note as well if homework will be completed <i>between</i> sessions or is <i>pre-work</i> to be completed prior to first class session.	3 weeks gap between sessions to allow students to work on project as much as possible to get ready for the next level during last class.
Any other information students will need	Purchase pattern for project on Ravelry – Lindal Täschlein by Wöldten Print a COLOR COPY prior to the start of class. All skeins should be wound PRIOR to the start of class. Bag is knitted at a very tight gauge, using Aran weight/Heavy Worsted on a size US #3 needle. ALL YARNS SHOULD BE HEAVY WORSTED OR ARAN WEGHT. I used Plied Yarns – PENN Ave Twist If yarn is finer, needle size will have to be extremely small.

Class Skill Level Descriptions:

Knitting

- Novice - No knitting knowledge or skills needed.
- Beginner - Can knit, purl, cast on and bind off.
- Advanced Beginner - Confident with knitting basics and ready to go to next level.
- Intermediate - Beginner level skills plus increase, decrease, and follow simple patterns.
- Advanced - Intermediate level skills plus yarn over patterns, cables, ribbing, comfortable with pattern interpretation.
- All Levels - This class is of interest regardless of knitting skill level.

Crochet

- Novice - No crochet knowledge or skills needed.
- Beginner - Can chain, single crochet, and double crochet.
- Intermediate - Confident with crochet basics and ready to go to next level.
- Advanced - Beginner level skills plus increase, decrease, and follow simple patterns.
- All Levels - This class is of interest regardless of crochet skill level.
