Class write-up / description	Is it a bouquet of flowers? Is it a blanket? It’s both! In this 2-session class, you will learn how to knit this ingenious blanket that rolls up into a bouquet of flowers. In the first class session, we will cover the basics of the pattern and begin our blanket. We will then have a break of a couple of weeks to enable you to progress your work. In the second session, we will learn how to make the flowers that adorn the edges and how to attach them.

Pre-requisites for class	Confident with knitting basics and ready to go to next level.
Materials needed for class	DK Weight/Light Worsted Weight yarn – Recommended yarn: Cascade 220 Superwash: • 200g main color for the blanket (2 balls) • 100g green for border and leaves (1 ball) • 100g flower color if choice (1 ball – more if you want to do more than one color flower) • US Size 8 / 4mm double pointed needles; Size 8 circulars 24” and 40”
Skills/techniques learned	• Increasing • Decreasing • Pattern reading
Homework required (please note as well if homework will be completed <i>between</i> sessions or is <i>pre-work</i> to be completed prior to first class session.	There will be a break of several weeks between the sessions to enable participants to make progress on the blanket, and to be ready to make and affix the flowers in the second session.
